## APPLICATION CRITERIA – Leapfrogs 2023

There are formal criteria as well as assessment criteria for the Leapfrogs cheques. If the formal criteria are fulfilled and all questions answered according to the application guidance, a jury will go through your application to decide on approval or not. Read carefully the criteria and guidance below in the application process to make your application complete and competitive.

### Formal criteria

- You should have at least one credit registered after 2022-05-31 (one year before the start date of Leapfrogs 2023) at either Lund University, Malmö University, Kristianstad University, or Blekinge Institute of Technology.
- You intend to work three months full time with your project during summer 2023.
- You will participate in the mandatory activities
- A Swedish social security number ("personnummer" alt. "samordningsnummer"). *If you are an international student staying for less than a year, and thereby not eligible for a samordningsnummer, we accept a temporary number given to you by e.g. your university.*
- A student may only be awarded the Leapfrog check twice. If you have been awarded the check on two previous occasions, you do not meet the formal criteria.

## Assessment criteria

We also have some assessment criteria. A jury that reviews the applications will judge based on these. In addition to the application itself, the jury might also, when required, have an interview with the applicant. The assessment criteria are:

- The long-term potential of the project
- The entrepreneurial ability of the applicant
- If the project is innovative
- That the Leapfrogs cheque makes a difference to the project
- The description of expected achievements during the project time
- The idea's connection to the Sustainable development goals, Agenda 2030

In addition to these criteria, the jury welcomes if you have had any contact with someone from the innovation system regarding the idea. However, this is not a requirement.

The application is individual and should be written by you only. If you are two, or more, members from the same project applying for the scholarship, we recommend that you do not use the same text in the application. The scholarship is awarded to individuals, not to projects. It is not guaranteed that all people from the same project are awarded the scholarship since the applications are assessed individually. If you are several applicants from the same project, it is unlikely that more than a maximum of two team members will be awarded a Leapfrog check.
