### **Obligations – Sustainability fund for students 2023**

If you receive a grant from the sustainability fund, you're obligated to work with your project full-time during the project time. You are also committed to participate in follow-up activities during the project time. The follow-up activities are not there to be a burden but rather a way for you to gain more experience that you can apply to future projects and a way for us to see your process in your current project.

We want to be close to the project and see how it proceeds. We will meet occasionally (digitally and in-person). The most important channels for follow-up are the

- Status updates
- The workshops
- The post-project survey and maybe an interview.

#### **Project updates**

Everyone who receives a grant from the sustainability fund is obligated to document the project's progress via status updates. These updates will be shared in our internal Slack workspace. They will be shared with the other projects, as we want you to share your experiences and challenges that you encounter while working on your project. We also want you to interact with other projects and take the opportunity to support each other and share lessons.

We do not want to impose strict requirements regarding the content of your status updates, but if you fail to participate, we reserve the right to withdraw future payments. Following are the minimum requirements concerning your activity (note that minor changes can occur prior to the start of the projects):

- Three status updates during the Leapfrogs project in English

## Workshops

The first workshop is an approximately two-hour digital kick-off in May (date tba). Participation in this workshop is mandatory for all participants.

The workshops throughout the project period serve as a support function for the participants by providing skills and networking opportunities. These workshops are normally arranged in beginning/mid-June and mid/end of August. In addition to this, you will be offered additional support from the sustainability fund.
