

OBLIGATIONS – LEAPFROGS 2024

As a recipient of the Leapfrogs cheque, you will have certain obligations to fulfil throughout the duration of your project in 2024. These responsibilities are designed not only to ensure the successful completion of your project but also to provide valuable learning experiences that can benefit your future endeavours.

Full-time Commitment

Receiving this cheque requires your full-time dedication to the project. This means you should not be engaged in other studies or employment during the Leapfrogs project period. Your focus and energy should be solely on advancing your Leapfrogs project.

Participation in Follow-up Activities

The follow-up activities are an integral part of the Leapfrogs experience. They are not meant to be burdensome but are in place to help you gain more insights and apply these learnings to both your current and future projects. These activities also allow us to monitor and understand your progress.

Methods of Follow-up

- Status Updates: Regular updates on your project's progress are required. These updates will be shared within our internal Slack workspace, offering a platform for all Leapfrog participants to exchange experiences and challenges. The interaction among Leapfroggers is encouraged to foster mutual support and knowledge sharing.
- Workshops: These are structured to support Leapfrogs
 participants by enhancing skills and offering networking
 opportunities. The workshops are typically scheduled for
 early/mid-June and mid/end of August. Additionally, a kick-

off meeting is planned for May. <u>Attendance at these workshops is mandatory.</u>

- Peer Groups: You will be part of a peer group consisting of other Leapfrogs participants. Active participation in this group is expected, as it provides an avenue for sharing experiences and lessons learned outside of the formal workshop sessions.
- Post-Project Survey: At the end of your project, we are eager to hear about your accomplishments and the lessons learned during the course of your Leapfrog project.

Documentation and Requirements

- You are required to document your project's progress through at least three status updates in English during the Leapfrogs project period.
- While we aim to be flexible regarding the content of these updates, failure to participate in this crucial aspect of the program may result in the withdrawal of future payments.

By adhering to these obligations, you will not only ensure compliance with the terms of the Leapfrogs cheque but also enhance your own experience and development throughout the project.

Please note that minor changes to these requirements may occur before the project starts.
